SEASON TICKETS (Home Games Only)

All orders for season tickets received prior to July 1 will be filled before any consideration is given to orders for individual tickets. THERE WILL BE NO LIMIT ON SEASON TICKETS.

The season ticket, which costs \$8.00, will include our two home games: Vanderbilt and Alabama.

ALL PRIORITIES

Permanent Season Ticket Orders—July 1
 Season tickets will be set aside in the
 same location as last year for permanent
 season ticket buyers UNTIL JULY 1 and
 will be mailed before all other ticket or ders are filled. Alumni who are also mem bers of the GSEF are given priority on
 permanent season tickets. Most GSEF
 members will want to be on the perma nent season list to assure themselves of
 the same seat location each year.

2. Other Season Ticket Orders-July 1

Non-permanent season ticket orders to receive priority must be in the Athletic Ticket Office by JULY 1. Alumni who are also GSEF members are given priority on season tickets according to their GSEF classification. Other alumni will have priority on season tickets.

Tickets in excess of the number allotted, according to your priority classification, will be assigned in a less desirable location. Individual game tickets cannot be placed adjacent to season tickets, but will be grouped together in another location. No limit will be placed on the total number of tickets for any one game, except Tech, Auburn and Florida unless demand makes limitation necessary.

3. Individual Ticket Orders-July 15

a. Georgia Student Educational Fund, Inc. (Bulldog Clubs)

Members of the GSEF will receive priority on individual ticket orders if they prefer not to use season tickets. The number of priority Texas, Tech, Florida and Auburn tickets for GSEF members will be allotted according to GSEF classification.

b. Other Alumni

An alumnus who purchases season tickets will have preference in buying two South Stand Tech tickets. If there are any Tech tickets remaining after the orders of GSEF members and other season ticket purchasers have been filled, they may be purchased by alumni but will be limited to two per alumnus as long as they last.

An alumnus may buy one priority Texas ticket in East or West stand for each season ticket purchased. THERE WILL BE NO LIMIT ON TEXAS TICKETS.

Other alumni will be limited to four Florida and two Auburn tickets.

Please indicate on your order if you are a University of Georgia alumnus. Failure to do so places you in the general public category.

c. All Others

All other orders are filled in priority of date received.

TECH TICKETS

Our allotment of tickets from Georgia Tech for the game in Atlanta is 11,000 of which approximately 8,000 are beyond the goal line or in the South Stand end zone. By direction of the University Administration, Georgia students and the Georgia Band are allotted tickets in the East Stands which will leave very few East Stand tickets for alumni.

Georgia Tech will play the University of Kentucky an afternoon game on Grant Field in Atlanta, Georgia on September 21. You may order tickets for the Kentucky-Tech game from Mr. Howard Ector, Business Manager, Department of Athletics, Georgia Tech, Atlanta, Georgia. The University of Georgia will not handle any of these Kentucky-Tech tickets.
